

SKILLS SHORTAGE PUTS FOCUS ON IT TRAINING

Even in a high-unemployment environment, a shortage of skilled IT workers remains, forcing companies to focus on training to improve their workforce.



A shortage of skilled IT workers has forced 31% of companies to increase spending on IT staff education. That's an increase from 19% prior to the pandemic.

38% of CIOs and IT directors want to focus on education for workers, compared to 20% before the pandemic.



36% are investing in automation of IT tasks, with 47% of companies with 1,001 to 5,000 employees investing in automation.
